**Note** - Agricultural chemical labels must be read carefully as some may state a requirement that is more strict than the provincial regulations for persons applying chemicals. For example, the label may say something like “to be applied by authorized persons”. In those cases, the label instructions would supersede the applicator requirements, and must be followed.
