Subject: CORRECTION NOTICE - Version 6.2 (2014) Food Safety Manuals

## **CORRECTION NOTICE**

Please note the following important correction to the CanadaGAP Food Safety Manual for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables and the CanadaGAP Food Safety Manual for Greenhouse Product, Versions 6.2 (2014). This correction relates to testing water used for cleaning. The requirement stated that water from a municipal source had to be tested when used for cleaning; this was an error and is not the intent of the requirement. We have also clarified where the water sample is to be taken from.

## Effective for the 2014 season:

Section 15.1 Water Assessment is revised as follows:

Water for Cleaning (equipment, buildings, containers, etc. and hand washing in personal hygiene facilities) (If not applicable, proceed to the Section: 15.2 Storage)

- The person responsible uses potable water:
  - ☐ For cleaning buildings, equipment, containers, etc. (FOR ALL COMMODITIES EXCEPT FOR PROCESSING POTATOES)
  - In personal hygiene facilities for hand washing
- At least twice annually—The person responsible tests the water for Total Coliforms and E. coli using
  an accredited lab where analyses are performed to standards equivalent to ISO 17025, to ensure
  that the water (even if it is from a municipal source) is potable (File under Tab: Test Results) Refer
  to Appendix G: Water Testing
  - Once prior to use
  - At least once more during the season to ensure water potability is being maintained
- ☐ The person responsible ensures the water sample is taken from the appropriate location (e.g., equipment, tap, storage cistern/tank/container, etc.). The person responsible ensures the water sample is taken from the water source as close as possible to where the water is used.
