Subject: CORRECTION NOTICE – Version 6.3 (2015) Food Safety Manuals

CORRECTION NOTICE

Please note the following correction to the CanadaGAP Food Safety Manual for Fresh Fruits and Vegetables and the CanadaGAP Food Safety Manual for Greenhouse Product, Versions 6.3 (2015). This correction relates to Section 21. *Transportation*. Previously, the circle bullets at the beginning of this section did not accurately reflect all the situations or types of operations that would be required to complete this section.

Effective for the 2015 season:

Section 21. *Transportation* is revised as follows:

21. Transportation

RATIONALE:

Transportation vehicles that do not have properly cleaned and/or maintained food contact surfaces may be a potential source of contamination to product. Bulk transport is included within 21.1 of this section. Product release procedures include inspecting outgoing product for signs of contamination before loading onto vehicles.

- Bulk product is transported
- Product in harvested packaging materials is transported from the premises
- Product in market ready packaging materials is transported from the premises

If ANY of the above circles has been checked off, proceed below. If not, proceed to Section 22: Identification and Traceability.
