If you're due to complete a self-assessment this season, complete it and send it to <u>your new certification body</u> at least 30 days before your certificate expires.

We will forward the transfer request to your new certification body. In all cases, the new certification body will review your file and confirm when you will need your next audit. You can expect they will ask you for additional information (e.g., details about your operation, a copy of your previous audit report, your signature on a new contract, etc.). Please let us know if you need our assistance.
