The CanadaGAP Program is pleased to announce that the Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) on the CanadaGAP website have been updated, reorganized and streamlined for ease of use.

We invite you to use the FAQs as a primary resource to answer specific questions, as well as to obtain an overview of common questions for all program participants, auditors and other interested parties.

The FAQs previously existed in two separate places on the CanadaGAP website and were addressed to two separate audiences: program participants and auditors. However, the FAQs have been compiled into one forum for usability and to ensure that the information contained is readily available to all.
