

## **CanadaGAP Training Note**

**To:** CanadaGAP Auditors and Certification Bodies

**Date:** May 30, 2019

**Subject:** Chlorothalonil (Bravo) Label

This training note is to advise auditors and certification bodies that, due to the removal of old chlorothalonil labels from the Pest Management Regulatory Agency (PMRA) website, auditees who need to access the old label online will have to do so via the Syngenta website. The name brand for this commonly-used agricultural chemical is Bravo.

The old formulations continue to be acceptable for use until the phase-out date agreed between PMRA and Syngenta (May 2020); however, only the label for the new formulations of the chemical are available on the PMRA website.

Typically, many auditees do not keep physical labels and instead refer to the PMRA website for a copy of the label. Auditors also typically look for labels on the PMRA website; therefore, we are letting you know that these labels cannot be accessed there, although use of the product continues to be acceptable for another year.
